Japanese Encephalitis (JE) is a disease spread through mosquito bites. Domestic pigs and wild birds (herons) are reservoirs of the virus. Transmission to humans may cause severe symptoms and may cause death.

Neurogical sequelae Fever Headache Vomitina Neck stiffness


Myalaia Abdominal pain Convulsion

Fatality rate | 30%




JE Virus is transmitted to humans through bites from INFECTED CULEX MOSQUITOS
